Create a Custom Data Wall:


- 1. Log in, District Code 1876
- 2. Dashboard




3. Menu: Choose the Charting Icon



4. Select Custom Grade Data Wall (entire grade) or Custom Class Data Wall (just your class).





- 5. Work your way through the following choices:
 - a. Year
 - b. User
 - c. Courses (any will work for this purpose)
 - d. Periods (choose all)
 - e. Assessment ... then click next



- f. Categories (choose the subject you are wanting to show data for)
- g. Assessment Groups (choose the assessment)
- h. Assessments (click all that you would like to appear on the data wall)
- i. Windows ... then search ... this will bring up the color-coded data wall

Notes:

- You can pin (move) a column by clicking the three horizontal lines at the top of the column.
- If you click on the word "Student" at the top of the student column, it will <u>rearrange the list of names</u> in different ways (low to high scores, alphabetical A-Z, alphabetical Z-A).
- If you click on the window name ("Fall") above any given column, you can rearrange the data as well.
- You can add and save comments for students by double-clicking in cells in the comments column.
- If this is a data wall you plan to go back to multiple times, you can <u>save it</u> by clicking Save Search at the top left. (It will then show up in the Charting section under Saved Searches.)
