- Friends are NOT permitted to eat with a student and their lunch visitor.
- We encourage all visitors to enjoy school hot lunch as food from outside restaurants CANNOT be brought into school. Having food delivered by an outside service to a student for lunch is also NOT allowed.

 Adult Visitor Lunch Price = \$4.65
- After lunch visitors are expected to immediately report to the office, sign out, and exit the building. Visitors are NOT allowed on the playground or to walk students back to class.
