

District Information

Stressing the importance of offering nutritious meals to children during the summer months, the School District of Wisconsin Rapids announces the sponsorship of the Summer Food Service Program.

The Summer Food Service Program provides nutritious meals to children during the summer when free and reduced-price school meals are typically unavailable. **Free meals will be made available to all children 18 years of age and under.** Persons over 18 years of age who are determined by a state or local public educational agency to be mentally or physically disabled and who also participate in a public or private non-profit school program during the regular school year may receive free meals as well. The following locations will be serving free meals this summer:
