President John Krings called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Roll Call

Motion by Christopher Inda, seconded by Kathi Stebbins-Hintz to move into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. §19.85(1)(c) for the purpose of considering a wage compensation adjustment for an individual employee, and to consider the appointment of an individual to the Howe Elementary Principal position including individual contract, wage, and benefit compensation for the position. Motion carried unanimously on a roll call vote.

Motion by John Benbow, seconded by Julie Timm to move into open session at 7:28 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by John Benbow, seconded by Kathi Stebbins-Hintz to approve of increasing School Nurse Payeng Xiong’s salary by \$3,000.00 effective July 1, 2023. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by John Benbow, seconded by Julie Timm to approve of the resignation of Steven Thayer from his Associate Principal position at Lincoln High School, and to appoint Steven Thayer to the position of Howe Elementary School Principal with a two-year, 210-day contract effective July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2026 at an annual salary rate of \$109,733.00 (95% of the \$115,508.00 base rate) for year one; and \$112,043.00 (97% of the \$115,508.00 base rate for year two), with administrator benefits. Motion carried unanimously.
