 Work with middle school students to find an engaging activity that they would like to attend Collaborate with pupil services team to put together a parent/guardian information session focusing on the needs of middle school students 	 Throughout the school year, we offered several opportunities for students to be in a social setting. Offering field trips opportunities such as Skate City, movie theater event, Cave of the Mounds, and a Fall Harvest event. Students were surveyed in their Friday classroom to determine preferred activities. These activities were included in the schedule each week. The needs of the middle school students varied drastically from last year. We met their needs via daily open lab, Zoom sessions, and Friday school interactions.
